What have been major socio-economic challenges in the history of the United States?

- Demographic changes: Major immigration from Europe in the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, resistance to immigration coming from non-White regions, opening the US to immigrants from the rest of the world (Immigration & Nationality Act, 1965).
- Slavery and post-slavery racism
  - o "Jim Crow" & Segregation; lynching and terrorism before WWII.
  - Educational segregation: Plessy v. Ferguson (1896) to Brown v. Board of Education of Topeka, Kansas (1954)
  - o Civil Rights Act (1965)
  - o NOT SHOWN: *The Great Migration* (1910-1970). African Americans from the South moving to the urban areas of the Midwest and Northern states.
- Major economic challenges (Great Depression, Great Recession of 2007-2009):
  Poverty in the U.S., family economic insecurity, decline of industrial manufacturing job, etc.
